Attend the open house to learn more, and contribute, to the Regional Active Transportation Plan. The plan will define a preferred network of pedestrian corridors and bicycle parkways that link the region and will make it easy to get to work and school, run errands and have fun walking and bicycling.

The plan will amend Regional Transportation Plan, updating policies, targets and performance measures and establishing priorities for funding.

The high-level active transportation network is envisioned to be constructed incrementally with each segment connecting and resulting in a region-wide, interconnected system.
